To assess patient's eligibility and interest in registering for CMS

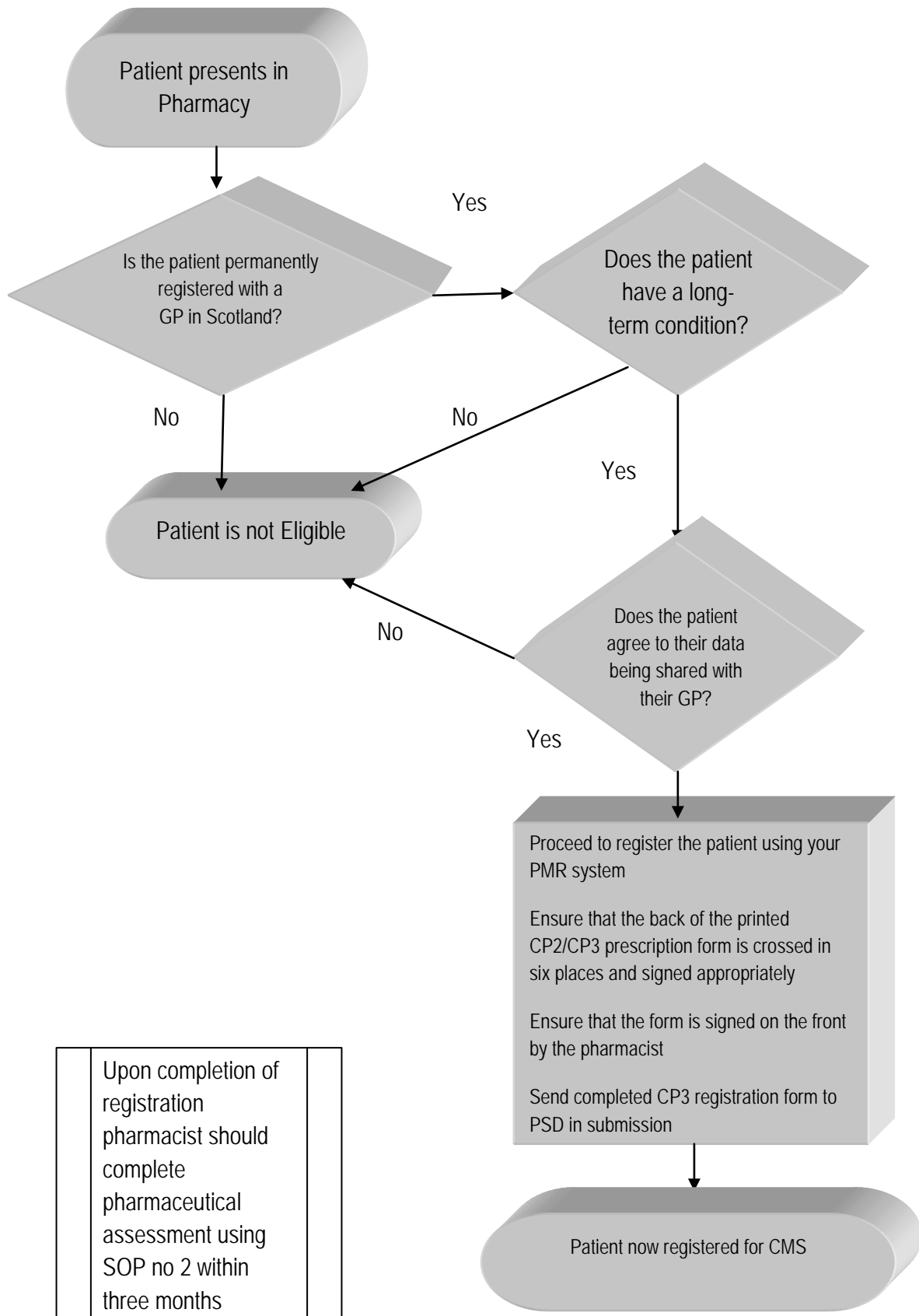
To ensure patients give informed consent that their clinical data will be shared with their GP
